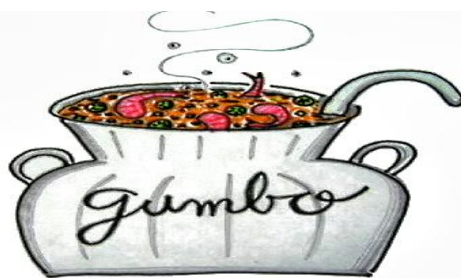


Valentine's Sweetheart Party








